Registration fees

- ◆ Fees per run 20 \$ **SPECIAL**: \$ 100 for 6 runs with the same dog / \$ 75 for 4 runs with the same dog
- ◆ Additional fee for a dog not individually registered with the CKC (per trial) \$ 9.00
- ◆ Make your check on behalf of Club Agilité Montérégie. Please do not postdated checks.
- ◆ A fee of \$ 25 will be charged for NSF checks.

Registration

- ◆ Only dogs already registered individually in the Canadian Kennel Club Register or who are qualified for such registration may be entered the trial.
- ◆ Registration forms must be completed in detail. Exhibitors will be responsible for any errors made during entry.
- ◆ No entry will be accepted without payment of the registration fee. Incomplete entries will be returned.
- ◆ The presentation of a non-redeemable check to pay the entry fee is considered a failure to pay and is therefore considered an offense subject to disciplinary action and cancellation of awards, prizes and scores.

Non-CKC Member Participation Fee

- ◆ Canadians who are not members of the CKC must pay an annual membership fee for non-members for all prizes and titles. The fee will be the same as the fee charged for an event registration number. To protect the prizes and titles obtained, a non-member must choose either to become a member of the CKC or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply with this obligation within 30 days of notification will result in the cancellation of all prizes and titles obtained. These fees apply only to dogs that are the exclusive property of non-CKC members. They are not required for CKC members.

Cross-breed and unrecognized breed dogs at CKC performance events

- ◆ The Canadian Kennel Club, with a view to broadening its scope and being more accessible to all, is pleased to announce that, as of July 1, 2014, cross-breed and breed dogs not recognized by the CKC (Purebred dogs registered in a register recognized by the CKC) will be able to participate in the competitions of agility, obedience and rally obedience of the CKC, alongside the purebred dogs and to obtain the same titles.
- ◆ To have the pleasure of participating in CAC events, owners of cross-breed or unrecognized breeds must apply for a dog companion (CCN) number (<http://www.ckc.ca/CanadianKennelClub/files/1f/1f0d6264-636f-4dc2-b295-1e09c07a8bc1.pdf>) and meet the eligibility criteria in the Canine Companion Policy.

Advancement

Dogs that have received a title just before the trial date will be admitted to the next level provided the Trial Secretary is notified one week prior to the contest date.

- ◆ Transfers to the next level will be available the same day by completing the form provided on site.

Notice to competitors

- ◆ The competition venue will be outside on a grassed area, in a fenced enclosure. No provisions were made in case of rain or sun. The competition will take place, rain or shine, we invite you to prepare accordingly.
- ◆ The size of the ring is 100 'x 140'.
- ◆ Only officially registered dogs will be allowed on the premises.
- ◆ The space for tents and cages is limited. Please bring your chairs.
- ◆ Please pick up your garbages and your dog's poop.
- ◆ All dogs must be kept on a leash, except during their runs and in the section designated for warm up.
- ◆ No food or other reward will be tolerated on the course. The dog can wear a buckled collar, quick release or no collar. Please note that no medals or decorations are permitted on the collar.
- ◆ Each competitor participates in the event at his / her own risk. The release form on the registration form must be signed.
- ◆ All agility barriers will be selected from those listed and described in the CKC rules book.
- ◆ KBTCC reserves the right to refuse any registration in accordance with the rules of the CKC.
- ◆ An electronic timer will be used in all classes.

Reserve list, refunds

- ◆ No entries will be accepted, changed, canceled, substituted after the closing date, except as noted below.
- ◆ If the registration deadline is reached before the closing date, a Reserve List will be produced. The dogs on this list will participate in the place of those absent. The owners of those who will not participate for a proven medical reason will be reimbursed.
- ◆ There will be no refund if the dog is absent on the day of the contest, or if the dog / handler is expelled by the contest committee for whatever reason, or if the temperature is inclement.
- ◆ Females in heat are not accepted. If a certificate from a veterinarian certifying that the female has come in heat, within 10 days before the trial, is sent to the Trial Secretary prior to the trial day, the owner will be refunded.
- ◆ If a dog injures himself after his registration and the owner sends a certificate from a veterinarian attesting that the dog is injured, before the day of the trial, the owner will be refunded.

CKC agility Rules

- ◆ It is the responsibility of the club organizing the competition to ensure that judges, members, volunteers or participants are not subject to any indignity during the contest. The President of the Agility Contest will immediately report any infraction of this by-law to the CKC and the CKC Board of Directors will take all necessary action following an infraction.

Selected and Veteran Titles

Titles for Selected classes include an "S" at the end. Titles for Veteran classes include a "V".

The CKC allows the use of a number indicating a title of Excellence or Selected Excellence or Veteran Excellence earned a second, third or fourth time, e.g. AG.M.X.2 and so on.

Events offered

- ◆ Novice Agility (Standard, Jumper with Weaves, PAD): All dogs must start at this level.
- ◆ Intermediate Agility (Standard, Jumper with Weaves, PAD): For dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility title, and dogs that have earned the title of Intermediate Agility but have not obtained a qualifying score towards the title of Agility by Excellence.
- ◆ Agility by Excellence (Standard, Jumper with Weaves, PAD): For dogs that have acquired the title of Intermediate Agility, but have not obtained the title of Agility by Excellence.
- ◆ Agility Master by Excellence (Standard or Jumper with Weaves, PAD): For dogs that have acquired the title of Agility by Excellence or the title of Agility Master by Excellence.
- ◆ Jumps and Tunnels: For all dogs
- ◆ Challenge International (Standard, Jumper with Weaves): For all dogs

Divisions – Regular, Selected or Veteran

Dogs can be registered only in one of these three divisions during a trial.

Regular Division

- ◆ A dog who enters a CKC agility competition will be entered in the Regular class, unless otherwise indicated by the owner / handler.

Selected Division

- ◆ The owner may choose to register the dog in the Selected Division rather than the Regular Division at any trial. The dog must only be register in either Selected or Regular classes and can not pass alternately from Selected classes to Regular classes. When a dog has been register in a Selected class, it can no longer compete in Regular classes.
- ◆ The passage of a dog to the Selected Division is lateral, ie it retains the qualification scores obtained in Regular classes. All rules applicable to Regular classes apply to Selected classes, except for the standard course time and jump heights. The SCT of the Selected class is established by adding 10% to the time of the dogs in the Regular class.

Veteran Division

- ◆ At the discretion of the handler, a dog of seven (7) years or older may be registered in the Veteran Division. Once a dog has been Registered as Veteran, he / she can no longer be register in Regular and Selected classes. The dog retains his titles and / or qualification scores obtained for a title. The letter V for veteran will be added to all new titles obtained (eg AG.M.X.V).
- ◆ All veteran dogs run the same classes as Regular dogs but can jump one or two jump heights lower than they would in Regular class. The SCT is established by adding 10% to the time of the dogs in the Regular class.

Jumps height

Dog height (at the withers)	Regular jump height	Select jump height	Veteran jump height
10 inches and less	8 inches	4 inches	4 inches
More than 10 inches and up to 14 inches	12 inches	8 inches	4 inches ou 8 inches
More than 14 inches and up to 18 inches	16 inches	12 inches	8 inches ou 12 inches
More than 18 inches and up to 22 inches	20 inches	16 inches	12 inches ou 16 inches
More than 22 inches	24 inches	20 inches	16 inches ou 20 inches

The height of the tire is 4 "(on jump height lower) less than the height of the other jumps, except for dogs jumping 4 inches. For example, if a dog jumps 20 inches, the tire will at be 16 inches.

The owners will be responsible for any errors made during registration. Dogs participating in a lower division than theirs will be eliminated. The judges reserve the right to measure certain dogs.

Ribbons and rosettes

- ◆ All classes: Placement ribbons will be awarded from 1st to 4th place in all divisions and all height categories, for qualifying scores only.
- ◆ All dogs obtaining a qualifying score will receive a Qualifying ribbon.
- ◆ A special KBTCC rosette will be awarded for CKC title earned in this agility trial.

Familiarization / Practice jumps

- ◆ There will be no familiarization period. A practice jump will be available near the ring.
